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Topics

This year we have several new, exciting topics in Year 5. This half-term our topic will be Mission Control, in which we will learn all about Space. We will also be learning about lots of other interesting things this year, including America, sources of energy and Shakespeare.

Homework

Unfortunately, we are not able to send out homework at this point due to the current COVID situation. Our main target at this moment is to maintain the smooth running of the school day and we will look at the feasibility of homework, after school clubs etc, once routines are established.

Home Reading

We have organised a new system for home reading books to ensure children are not taking books home that have just been used by another child. All books that children return to school will be placed in a basket which will then be stored away for 48 hours. Please ensure children are reading each night and you have signed their reading records. These should be in school every day and can be used as a means of communication between home and school. In Year 5, the expectation is for children to read their book for at least 10 minutes every night. The children will also be able to choose a reading for pleasure book which they can read as often as they like.

Uniform

Please make sure your child is in their full school uniform each day. If you have not yet collected your child's free jumper and tie, please see the main school office. Please label all items of uniform.

A reminder that our school uniform consists of:

- Maroon jumper with school logo
- White shirt
- Maroon striped tie
- Grey skirt or pinafore/trousers
- Black school shoes

PE/PE Kits

PE takes place twice a week for children in KS1 and three times a week for KS2. For Year 5, PE will take place on Tuesday, Thursday and Friday. Although we are asking that PE kits are left in school until the October half term for ease of routine, if you do wish to take your child's PE kit home at the end of the week to wash, we simply ask that you ensure it is returned to school for their next PE lesson. Children won't be able to take part in PE unless their kit has been returned to school. Please ensure all earrings are removed on PE days.

A reminder that our school PE kit consists of:

- Plain sky blue polo shirt,



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- Plain maroon shorts
- Plain maroon or black tracksuit bottoms
- Plain maroon sports jumper
- White sports socks
- Trainers.

General Reminders

- Please make sure your child is only bringing the following items into school – book bag (including reading record and reading book), PE kit, lunchbox and water bottle. (Children are able to have water in the classrooms, no juice please.)
- Children are allowed to bring fruit or vegetables as a snack for playtime.
- The gates are now open from 8.30am until 9.00am at the start of the day, and 2.45pm until just after 3.00pm at the end of the day, to minimise crowding
- Please ensure there is only one adult collecting your child from the playground
- Please ensure you complete the appropriate form on Parent App if you would like your child to walk home alone. If you wish for your child to bring in their phone for walking home, they must hand it to their class teacher each morning. Please note we cannot take responsibility for the phone.
- If your child requires an inhaler, please ensure that they have one in school that is in date and clearly labelled. A care plan must be completed if your child has an inhaler in school.

Meeting with teachers

If you wish to speak to your child's class teacher, you will need to wait until all of the other children have been collected at the end of the day. If you do not collect your child from school, please phone the main school office and ask for a phone call or meeting to be arranged. All queries or concerns need to go through the class teacher in the first instance.
